READ GENERAL RULES

Social Security Number must be presented at the time of entry.

1. The general rules of the Ford County Fair shall apply to this department.
2. All entries (except waterfowl. i.e. domestic fowl that swim, such as ducks and geese) in a show or exhibition shall have originated in US Pullorum – Typhoid clean or equivalent hatchery or flock or have a negative pullorum – typhoid test within 90 days prior to exhibition. Exhibitor shall show proper information before admission to show.

3. American Standard Book of Perfection will be the judging guideline.
4. All entries for the show should be made at the fairgrounds on Saturday June 29, 2019 by 10:45 am. Each exhibitor must fill out their own entry form which indicates your acceptance of the show rules.
5. Entry fees: \$1.50 per entry. Fee must be paid at time of making entry.
6. There will be an exhibitor fee of \$10.00
7. All poultry must have numbered leg band.
8. Minimum age of all poultry is 8 weeks except fryer, maximum age of 2 years. And the judges reserve the right to eliminate immature birds.
9. Each exhibitor may show as many breeds as they want but are limited to a maximum of only 2 entries per class number.
10. All meat Production birds must be hatched after January 1st. These birds may not be shown in any other class.
11. Prior to being used to transport poultry to a show, all crates, boxes, containers and vehicles shall be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.
12. This association will not be responsible for loss from fire, theft, accidents or destruction. Every precaution will be taken to prevent the same.
13. All birds must be owned and in exhibitors care by June 1st except for meat production.
